## 2010 STREET DANCE VOLUNTEER INSTRUCTIONS - BEER

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Cash machine available inside ice arena
- Blue polo shirts identify 4<sup>th</sup> of July Committee members. If you have questions and can't find Deb Heinecke, Stacie Karkhoff or Brandon Klement, Ice Arena Manager, ask one of them.
- The street dance is open from 5:30 to midnight. The band begins playing at 7 PM. Ticket sales to
  purchase alcoholic beverages STOPS at 10:30 PM; serving of alcoholic beverages STOPS at 11:00.
  These times MUST be observed
- Eight police officers will be at the event; one at every gate, one at the beer stand and others roaming the crowd.
- All volunteers still at the event at 11:00 are asked to help gate people monitor the crowd as it leaves to make sure no alcohol is taken outside the gates. The police will "sweep" the crowd out at midnight. Also, we REALLY can use help in cleaning up. It can be done in a half-hour if everyone helps. If there are enough people at the gates, we can start cleaning at 10:30 or as the crowd vacates tables.
- Every volunteer will get 2 tickets for as a thank you. Pick them up after your shift. Those working
  the last shift should get them before and consume the beverage BEFORE working. No alcohol can
  be consumed while working. Water and pop may be consumed.

## BEER SPECIFICS

- Only those assigned to serve are allowed to serve.
- NO alcoholic beverages are to be consumed by volunteers while they are working their shifts.
- IMPORTANT! ONLY those with a wristband are to be served/have a alcoholic beverage in their hand. If they have a band but look too young, you MUST card them. Date of birth: must be prior to 7/4/89.
- DO NOT serve anyone who looks/acts like they have had too much alcohol.
- Contact the police person in the area if you have ANY questions or problems.
- We will have Cab information at the Info area.
- All alcoholic beverages are served in our cups. Do not pour it into their containers.
- If anyone gives tickets for more than one cup, remind them that someone under 21 <u>cannot</u> have it in their hand. If anyone under 21 and/or no wristband is found holding one, it will be taken away.
- Remind people presenting tickets from 10:00 on that all drinks must be consumed by 11:00 PM.
- ONE ticket per cup.
