2010 STREET DANCE VOLUNTEER INSTRUCTIONS - TICKETS

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Cash machine available inside ice arena
- Blue polo shirts identify 4th of July Committee members. If you have questions and can't find Deb Heinecke, Stacie Karkhoff or Brandon Klement, Ice Arena Manager, ask one of them
- The street dance is open from 6:00 PM 11:0 PM. The band begins playing at 6 PM. Ticket sales to
 purchase alcoholic beverages STOPS at 10:30 PM; serving of alcoholic beverages STOPS at 11:00.
 These times MUST be observed.
- Eight police officers will be at the event; one at every gate, one at the beer stand and others roaming the crowd.
- All volunteers still at the event at 11:00 are asked to help gate people monitor the crowd as it leaves to make sure no alcohol is taken outside the gates. The police will "sweep" the crowd out at midnight. Also, we REALLY can use help in cleaning up. It can be done in a half-hour if everyone helps. If there are enough people at the gates, we can start cleaning at 11:00 or as the crowd vacates tables.
- Every volunteer will get 2 tickets for as a thank you. Pick them up after your shift. Those working
 the last shift should get them before and consume the beverage BEFORE working. No alcohol can
 be consumed while working. Water and pop may be consumed.

TICKET SPECIFICS

- For beer and bacardi drinks "mojito and raspberry" ONLY.
- Tickets are \$3.00 each, this includes sales tax. One glass per ticket.
- Tell people liquor sales end at 11:00 PM, especially do so after 10:00 PM
- <u>DO NOT</u> sell tickets to anyone without a wristband. If they have one, but seem too young, you
 <u>MUST</u> ask for an ID. Be assertive you are important and in charge. <u>DO NOT</u> sell tickets to
 someone who is intoxicated. One person should find a police person to deal with the situation.
- Food sales are cash to the vendors. Tell people this.
